School Gateway—booking clubs

Please ensure that you have booked your child into any chosen clubs and have completed the booking with payment. If you are unable to book your child in to a club, it means that the club is full and we are unable to allocate any more spaces due to staffing ratios. We understand that there are emergency occasions when last-minute arrangements need to be made, but in these cases, please contact the school office and Kate or a member of teaching staff will be able to assist you. We are obliged to contact parents who are more than 15 minutes late for pick-up for safeguarding reasons and if our clubs are full then we can only accommodate them for a short period of time/ in an emergency.

Please note there are 2 ways of paying for clubs, but only one way of putting your child on the club list. Please find the School Gateway instructions of how to book a club here. (The way you shouldn't do is here but it does tell you what to do if you do it this way). Thank you.

Finally, could parents **PLEASE** ensure that children's belongings are labelled clearly with their name. This includes shoes as many children have the same style of shoe, perhaps only slightly different in size if at all. Staff are spending a long time looking for lost items every day whilst encouraging the children to independently take care of their belongings, which is easier if they can spot their own name. Thank you.
